REPORT OF THE NEP WORKSHOP

IIHS, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, organized a workshop on NEP from 13 June-17 June, 2022, to create awareness and understanding amongst teachers about distinctive features of the NEP vis-à-vis curriculum modifications, shift in pedagogical proficiency and effective implementation of the flagship policy in higher education institutions. The illustrious resource persons and towering speakers at the workshop informed the participants that under the new policy, the undergraduate degree programme would be of four-year duration. Students can exit after one year with a certificate, after two years with a diploma, and after three years with a bachelor's degree. After four years, the student would be able to enter a research degree programme directly depending upon how well he or she has performed. Moreover, the master's degree programmes will continue to function as they do. The NEP proposes sweeping changes in the Indian educational ecosystem. The eminent speakers at the workshop stressed upon the need for a skilled workforce with multidisciplinary abilities across varied streams of knowledge for the successful implementation of the NEP. Aiming for equitable and inclusive education, the policy reaffirms every citizen's right to dream, thrive and contribute to the nation, bridging the social category gaps in access, participation and learning outcomes. NEP 2020 aims to provide infrastructure support, innovative education centres to bring back dropouts into the mainstream, besides tracking students and their learning levels, facilitating multiple pathways to learning involving both formal and non-formal education modes and association of counsellors or welltrained social workers with schools. Having a single regulator for higher education institutions, multiple entry and exit options in degree courses, the low-stakes board exams, and common entrance exams for universities - these are some of the key takeaways from the new policy. The workshop was attended by faculty, officers, administrative staff members, and senior professors.

Minutes of the Meeting:

In the Annual IQAC Meeting held virtually via Google Meet with the external stakeholders on September 23, 2022 at 11:00 a.m., the following was discussed and decided:

The Principal Ms. Santosh Bisla welcomed the guests and the Convener of IQAC Dr. Manju Singh presented the Report of IQAC.

The Key Note Speaker Sh. Shiv Raman Gaur, Director, Higher Education, DAV CMC, New Delhi praised the internal dialogues/meetings of IQAC of the college and emphasized to introspect-what is done and what needs to be done. He suggested for out of the box thinking to innovate and bring out bright ideas. He was of the view to prepare the agenda concretely and confine to it, accessing oneself and the areas to be discussed with concrete steps.

For best practices in Criterion VII, he suggested that

- · Through the volunteers/cadets/students of NSS/NCC/Sahyog Club (with the permission of CMO of the city), the college may identify 50 girls to be initiated as Health Workers who may assist patients in hospitals or guide them. Two benefits of this activity-one will be the social work and the other is that the students will develop compassion towards the patients.
- · Any 'Act of Compassion'/ help in family, friends and society may be acknowledged by teachers and recognized by the college.
- · The college to promote ethical values and encourage students to participate in the activitiesdonation of clothes, things etc. in orphanage (to make this as a part of your cumulative effort). The college to initiate and put boxes of donation in the campus.
- · Sh. Gaur emphasized on the holistic development of the students that is the prime mover of NEP 2020. The teachers to identify the students' strong characteristics like science student sings and paints. The teachers also to move outside books and help the students encounter and cope up with their stress and anxiety; therefore in order to make them become 'hard shells' later, good habits to be inculcated in them at an early stage of college life.
- Sh. Gaur referring to Swami Vivekanand said that positive ideas have great impact on the mind, therefore, there should be- Substitution of Thought and Thoughtlessness-meditation.

Dr. Neera Raghav, Chairperson, Department of Chemistry, KUK praised the excellent working of the college and said that IQAC is doing a lot for the enhancement and quality upgradation. Neera mam suggested that the IQAC needs to differentiate between performers and nonperformers. Felicitation of faculty members should be introduced and it should be for the students too. She further emphasized on the holistic approach and development and analyzed that activities should be performed in the college preferably in the offline mode, (If conducted online, it should be followed by an input/ feedback/ not questionnaire) not as attendee for certificate but for participation which includes input and feedback.

For best practices and extension activities, Prof. Neera suggested the introduction of moral ethics, skill development and social outreach programmes.

She further suggested that the faculty members should apply as Research Supervisors and Cosupervisors (introduced by the affiliating university-KUK under UGC guidelines). The faculty fulfilling the eligibility criteria may apply for the same as it is an important ingredient for faculty development.

Also, the college should try for MOU's from institutions. Prof. Neera also focused on to develop botanical area-where tulsi, mint and other antioxidant plants/small succulent herbs be planted.

Mr. R.K. Mittal, Director, Apurva Biotech., Karnal emphasized on strengthening Criteria V, i.e. for placements. Firstly, he said stress on to the analysis of the level of knowledge and confidence of students when they are about to pass out. He said that with the emergence of new private universities where the labs and faculty are world class and high research is done, how our students will cope? He suggested some measures:

- · The college to introduce a system of mandatory internships.
- Device some industries/institutes where the students may able to understand the practical work.
- Enhance the knowledge and confidence of students by practical assignments and presentations.

The college should organize lectures and invite people to motivate students with their success stories, preferably in entrepreneurship. Towards the end of the course, the students should know where to approach and where to apply for good job and carrier.

Mr. V. K. Singh, Chairman, Excellent Civil Academy, Karnal discussed the Scholarship schemes for students, strengthening Criterion V. He emphasized on free coaching schemes to be introduced by college for needy students, SC, ST, OBC and help them prepare for competitive exams.

The students to incorporate economic strength and develop social harmony as an employee and as an entrepreneur.

There has to be a shift from socialist economy to pseudo capitalist economy. Development of students as entrepreneurs through:

- Haryana Entrepreneur Policy 2020.
- MSME
- Private (Self) entrepreneurship to be promoted.

Ms. Sonia Saini, Ph. D Research Scholar, ISRO, College name- Indian Institute of Space Science and Technology, Kerela said that the students should excel in all spheres-etc. academics, sports, curricular to co- curricular and extra- curricular. Deep core rooted learning with understanding and practicing for students along with no time-domain for practicals was suggested by Ms. Sonia. She said that being an Alumna of the college she enjoyed all these facilities. She suggested the students to be consisitent, confident and not to care/ worry about time, just practice. She complimented the college for imparting core values in students. She further suggested that in the Library, Notice Board should be updated for Jobs/Govt., Research and Scholarships etc. Also, Moral lectures should be organized for students.

Through PPT, she demonstrated her research work and career too.

B.K. Preeti, Brahma Kumaris talked about spirituality and how the students can be guided to strengthen their mind, to make them mentally and emotionally strong.

She discussed the importance of spiritual health and holistic health and also the holistic managing of things through meditation. Humanity/ Social services and earning blessings is important for students' holistic growth. The students may be attached to

- Touch the Light Project.
- Value based programmes.
- No Anger Zone to be created in the college college for positive and pure vibrations and avoid psychosomatic diseases.

Mr. Shamsher Singh and Mrs. Monika Rana (Parents) appreciated the college and expressed their satisfaction for working of the college. Ms. Sarika Rana (B.Sc. II Medical) praised the college and its working as it organizes plethora of activities for holistic development. She said that the Principal and teachers boost the confidence of the students. Apart from maintaining regular activities, a lot is taught in the college for the holistic growth of students.

During interaction, some more measures were suggested as:

- · Official support to conduct research.
- · Budget allocation of research to be prioritized.

- Fishery Culture, Mushroom Culture Workshops to be organized for selfemployment/entrepreneurship.
- More security cameras to be installed in auditorium.
- No wastage of electricity- students to be assigned duties to switch off lights and fans before leaving the classes.
