Botany Department Activities (2023-2024)

- ➤ National Student Paryavran Competition: organized by DGHE, Haryana along with 'Paryavaran Sanrakshan Gatividhi' (PSG), scheduled from July 01, 2023 to August 21, 2023. PSG is a nationwide organization determined to take up the task of conservation and protection of environment. Under this campaign, an online quiz competition for students of all levels was organized. Another interesting aspect of this campaign was that the students were supposed to sow 10 seeds of any plant, get their picture clicked while doing so and upload it with the registration form. This was a part of their contribution to save our environment. Under the aegis of Eco-Club of our college, about 100 students of our college (49 students among these from B. Sc. Medical) participated in the above quiz competition with great zeal and were awarded with an E-Certificate by the PSG.
