Activity Report 2022-23

- A Workshop was organized by the department on the topic of "Intonation" for undergraduate and postgraduate students on 22 November 2022. The resource person was Ms Vandana Rana, who is a faculty member of the department itself. Through a lucid and well-documented PowerPoint Presentation, Ms Rana detailed the nuances of learning pitch variation to the non-native speakers of English. A total of 100 students attended the workshop.
