- In the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic, when normal classroom teaching was suspended, our faculty members took to online teaching with great gusto. They used innovative digital tools like Google Meet, Zoom, YouTube Videos, and Webex to impart knowledge to their students. Not only this, they left no stone unturned to ensure that the students adapt to the new pedagogy in a relatively smooth and efficient manner.
- Organized a National Level Online Essay Writing Competition & National Level Online Self-composed Poetry Competition on January 10, 2021 in order to foster creativity and artistic expression amongst students.
- Organized an Extension Lecture on the topic "Virginia Woolf's A Room of One's Own: A Critical Discussion" on January 04, 2021 to enlighten the students of M.A. about the intricacies of this polemic text. The Resource Person was Dr. Neena Arora (Retd. Associate Prof., Dyal Singh College, Karnal).

The literary events included English Caption Writing Competition and English Literature and Language Quiz. E-certificates were provided to participants who scored more than 80% in the quiz. 


